Université Paris-Saclay offers a comprehensive and varied range of Undergraduate, Master's and Doctoral degrees, renowned internationally for their quality thanks to its excellent research reputation and the commitment of its academic staff. Its **constituent faculties and institutes, component institutions and associate institutions** continue to develop the University's course offer with cutting-edge and specialised academic programmes in science and engineering, life sciences and health, social sciences and humanities.

With **275 laboratories** shared with national research organisations - the CEA, CNRS, IHES, INRAE, INRIA, INSERM and ONERA, Université Paris-Saclay represents **13% of France's research potential**.

Located in the south of Paris on vast territory across Paris, Orsay, Évry and Versailles, Université Paris-Saclay benefits from a strategic geographical and socio-economic position that is enhanced by its international visibility.
